MINORITY CELL

Netaji Satabarshiki Mahavidyalaya has a consistent record of reaching out to the minority class students from the adjacent areas since its establishment. Its location has a sizeable population of the minorities, and almost half of our students belong to the minorities. - 5. Registering the complaints in writing from of minority teachers, employees, and students and address it to concerned person for steps.
- 6. Having updated knowledge of the government benefits and facilities for the minority candidates.
