1. A One-Day State Level Webinar on Remote Sensing and GIS was organized by Department of Geography and IQAC, P.N. 2. Report of two-day state level webinar on "<u>Issues of Harassment: Public and</u> <u>Private</u>" on 22nd and 23rd July, 2021

The Anti-Sexual Harassment Cell and the Women's Grievance Cell with IQAC of Netaji Satabarshiki Mahavidyalaya arranged a webinar titled "Issues of Harassment: Public and Private" on 22nd and 23rd July, 2021. The resource persons were Prof. KavitaPanjabi, Dept of Comparative Literature, JU and Dr. Soma Bhadra Ray, Associate Professor, Dept of Bengali, WBSU and the themes of their discussion were "Sexual Harassment in Higher Education Institutions: Prevention and Redressal" and "Otimarite Meyera: Ghore O Baire" (Women inside home and at workplaces during pandemic) respectively.

The webinar was well attended by professors and students of the college as well as from other colleges and universities; around 80 participants were present on each day. Dr. Shree Chatterjee, Assistant Professor and HOD of Education and the convener of the Anti-Sexual Harassment Cell moderated the session of the 1st day and Dr. Hena Biswas, Assistant Professor of department of Bengali and the convener of the Women's Grievance Cell did the same for the 2nd day. The programme on the 1st day started at 12.00 noon with the inaugural speech of the principal of the college, Dr. Sudhanath Chattopadhyay who welcomed the speakers to deliver their lectures. Then Mr. Milinda Majumder, IQAC Coordinator, Associate Professor and HOD of Political Science delivered the keynote speech which was followed by an engaging introduction of the 1st

resource person by Mr. Anindya Dey, TCS and Associate Professor and HOD of Sociology. The first speaker, Prof. Kavita Panjabi spoke on the Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace Act 2013, how it extended to students, why educational institutions do need their own policies which are geared to the students, how the definition of workplace has been broadened and redefined. She argued that the promise of equality cannot be realized as long as there is sexual harassment in the workplace as it humiliates, robs a person of his/her dignity, can disturb a person psychologically and all these things together prevent a person from reaching his/her full capacity. She also elaborately discussed the effects of sexual harassment, the issues of gender justice, ICC and how 'Saksham' has provided the guidelines for the universities in this regard etc. After her lecture Mr. Anindya Dey moderated the interactive session and the programme of that day ended with his concluding speech.

The programme of the 2nd day started with the opening address by the principal of the college, Dr. Sudhanath Chattopadhyay at 4.00 p.m. and after that Dr. Antara Choudhury, Assistant Prof. (HOD), Dept. of Bengali introduced the honourable resource person of the day. Dr. Soma Bhadra Ray talked on how women have become more vulnerable especially during this pandemic, COVID 19, how gender role is imposed on them, how patriarchal society is denying them of their individuality and identity, how they are trapped in different discourses and most importantly how giving space in familial relationships has become a necessity nowadays. The interactivesession was moderated by Dr. Antara Choudhury. As the webinar was streamed live onthe official YouTube channel of the college, questions and comments of participants were conveyed to the resource persons from both the zoom platform and YouTube.


6. Report of the Webinar on 30/07/2021 (02pm to 06pm)
