
## **SWACHHTA HI SEVA CAMPAIGN**

#### **Details of the Activity:**



A team comprised of Gopal Nath, Sub Officer, Haridas Sarkar, Leader, Md. Jaharul Islam and Md. Golam Masud, Fire Operator and Prasenjit Mondal, A.F.O. on behalf of Ashoknagar Fire Brigade came to our college for campaign and demonstration. The officer present informed the students about different types of fires. Next, another officer gave a clear idea of what type of fire extinguishing method is appropriate for a particular type of fire. Then, they showed a short practical model how to put out a fire. After that teachers and students also gained practical experience of putting out fire with the help of fire brigade officers.

## Brief note on how students benefited from this programme:

Through this campaign, awareness about fire safety has been increased among the students and teachers. All of us especially the students gathered the knowledge to deal with emergency situations regarding fire extinguishing method. As a result, the students will be able to cope with any situation. 
# TREE PLANTATION PROGRAMME

#### Day 1: i) Survey of the local area

#### ii) Health and Nutrition Awareness Progamme

On the first day of Special Camp (22.02.2024) NSS volunteers surveyed the local area. They went to every house and talked with villagers about their every spheres of life and villagers talked with them very freely. Volunteers found various problems with these people. After that NSS unit organized an awareness programme on health and nutrition. **Dr. Prianjit Kayal**, an eminant doctor of **Calcutta National Medical College** delivered a speech on health and nutrition. In his lecture he was especially talking about children's health and nutrition. 


#### Day 7: i) Orientation programme of NSS volunteers


