### **Report of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (Half yearly report of the session 2024-25) (July – December)**

The prime responsibility of our college's IQAC is to initiate, plan, and supervise various activities necessary to increase the quality of education in an institution or college. The session 2024-25 is the second year of NEP, 2020. During the first six months of the session, we conduct various activities to improve the quality of our college.

#### **Mission of the IQAC (wef 01/09/23) [and Actions for implementation]**

- 1) IQAC of the college took necessary steps to arrange for periodic assessment and accreditation of institutions of higher education or units thereof, or specific academic programmes or projects;
  - a) We have already successfully submitted the Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) for the year 2022-23. The Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) for the year 2023-24 have been prepared for uploading.
  - b) On August 9, 2019, our college received a certificate from the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) of India. This certificate is valid for five years from the date of issuance. Therefore, starting August 9, 2024, we will be eligible for the next cycle of this accreditation process. NAAC coordinators (Smt.Prama Bhattacharya and Dr.Anwesha DasGupta) of the college took the initiative for the process to go 2nd cycle of NAAC for accreditation. On 26.11.2024 Dr.Tusar Kanti Ghara gave a lecture on the new binary system for the assessment of NAAC.

## Report of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (Half-yearly report of the session 2024-25) (2<sup>nd</sup> Half)

The period of NAAC accreditation will expire in July 2025. The IQAC initiated various activities and plans to address these two factors.

  - The Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) for the year 2023-24 was prepared and submitted on 31 January 2025. On 18 February 2025, the AQAR was accepted without any DTV.
  - On August 9, 2019, our college received a certificate from the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) of India. This certificate is valid for five years from the date of issuance. Therefore, starting August 9, 2024, we will be eligible for the next cycle of this accreditation process. NAAC coordinators (Smt. Prama Bhattacharya and Dr. Anwesha Das Gupta) of the college took the initiative for the process to go 2<sup>nd</sup> cycle of NAAC for accreditation.
  - Academic and Institutional data uploaded on the Government Portal and certificate of AISHE, for the session 2023-24, generated on 31.01.2025

The NAAC committee instructed all the conveners of all committees to submit their meeting resolutions within 30.06.2025.
